GOAL 1

3.1 Strengthen our range of programmes and activities to provide diverse opportunities which maximise the reach and reputation of the Fringe Trust portfolio.

3.2 Seek partnerships with creative individuals and organisations with diverse needs and interests to broaden our programs and expand our audience.

3.3 Intentionally collaborate with organisations, e.g. Artsenta, GASP, Moana House, Kōkiri Training Centre, and similar who represent diverse communities.

3.4 Provide fit-for-purpose Fringe Arts facilities and events for artists and audiences throughout the year.

4.1 Ensure appropriate workforce planning to enable organisational growth and staff wellbeing.
